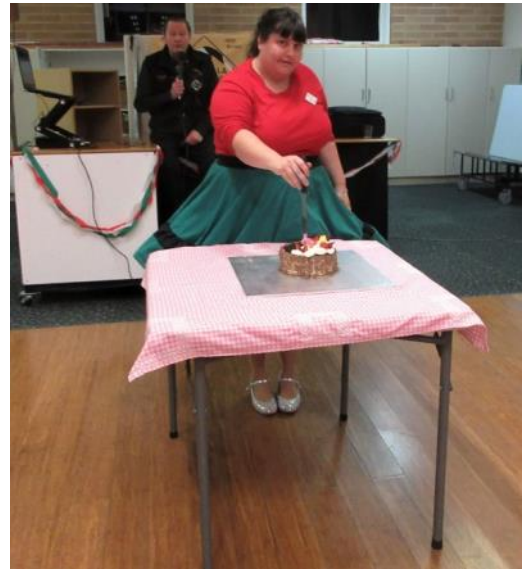
enjoyed the delicious birthday cake and of course lashings of strawberries and cream.

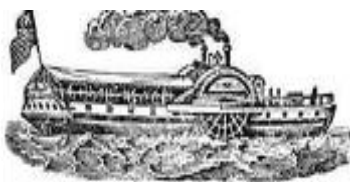
was some light, of course just as they were down and Jeff had packed up, the power came back on! We just put a couple of things back up in case it happened again. It was a good night of dancing though.
