

This issues cover celebrates Sunset Twirlers 23rd birthday held Saturday night, the following day celebrated 23 years of round dancing. a busy couple indeed!





We'll be launching our next learners' intake on Monday June 11th with a Charity Dance to support the Cancer Council of SA.




### WHYALLA TWIRLERS
