Convenor, April Nicholls, reported on planning for the State Convention in Port Broughton 28 – 30th August. Registration forms should now be available at Clubs as an alternative to Trybooking and dancers are encouraged to book accommodation early to avoid disappointment.

The draft outline of the Yearly Planner was accepted with further details to be added as changes are made to procedures.

A preliminary gathering for the formation of a sub-committee to revise the SASDS Constitution is to be held on 29th February. As a major overhaul of the Constitution was carried out in 2010, it is expected this will be mainly minor updating. Most importantly, however, some clauses need to be expressed more clearly to avoid misinterpretation, especially those relating to voting procedures at both Committee meetings and the AGM.

All recommendations from the subcommittee must be discussed & ratified by the full SASDS Committee. When completed, the proposed Constitution then needs to be approved by members at a Special General Meeting or the AGM. Once approved the Public Officer will lodge it with the Office of Consumer & Business Affairs. It is quite a process!





attendance enjoying dancing to callers from our South Australian clubs. This contributed to creating a great atmosphere together with the obligatory delicious supper.




