Making amends this issue with the inclusion below of Anne Tuckfields famous Date and Rice Bubble Tart recipe. This was sent to me some time ago and I have been reminded on a number of occasions to publish!

Always happy to sample the results.

DATE AND RICE BUBBLE TARTS

300 gr dates (chopped small)

250 gr brown sugar 250 gr margarine

3 cups rice bubbles

Put margarine, dates and sugar into a large saucepan over heat (boil) and stir until toffee like.

Mix in rice bubbles and allow to cool a little. Press into metal tart trays and refrigerate.

When set store in an air tight container in the fridge Place sheet of glad baking paper between layers.

When needed fill with whipped cream and top with fruit (bananas, strawberries or peaches).

Tarts will keep (unfilled) in fridge in an air tight container for 4-6 weeks.




