# Will next year's National Square Dance Convention in ADELAIDE be your first?

## 20th-24th April 2023

Scary thought! Five days of dancing? How will I cope?! If you haven't been to a National before, then you're probably wondering what to expect.

- Afternoon sessions on Saturday, Sunday and Monday cover Mainstream, Plus, Advanced, Rounds and Clogging. Your choice!
- The Sunday morning Dancer Interest Meeting is open for all dancers to hear updates from all states and future Conventions and take part in the discussions.
- **Don't forget the 50's Rock 'n' Roll theme night.** It will be a spectacular fun night at the Convention!

**STEP 3: Enjoy yourself** and dance as much or as little as you wish. You'll dance to callers and cuers from all over Australia, and perhaps some from overseas. You'll love the variety and experience some absolutely fantastic calling. During the Convention you'll meet lots of people and be able to make long lasting friendships.


