We are resuming our travels next year with a European River Cruise. As we have both joined the square dance community, we thought some of you may be interested in joining us. You do not need to be a line dancer to participate. We have a reputation for cramming as many experiences and sights possible into the time we have available. We don't have "the afternoon is at your leisure to sit in your room and waste time", it is not in our vocabulary, but of course you can if you want. We are not travel agents, just experienced travellers, we put together the itinerary and then have a wonderful agent price and book on our behalf.

### LDSA Central European Adventure 2024

This holiday has been in the planning for four years, but it is only now that we feel comfortable enough to take guests overseas with us again. We experienced post Covid-19 travel earlier this year with our Antarctica holiday from hell, so we feel we know many of the pitfalls of the "new world of travel". We will impart our tips at a couple of private gatherings prior to travel, to ensure it all goes smoothly.

We have chosen to cruise with "Viking Cruises" as it has been highly recommended. They do not have children or casinos on board, and provide tours included in the price every day. We have chosen the 14 night/15 day Grand European cruise on *Viking Egdir*, leaving Budapest on 21<sup>st</sup> August 2024. There are 3 different cabin alternatives, Standard, French Balcony and Full Balcony. French Balcony is an additional \$2000 per person (and a smaller cabin), which we do not think is worth the money, but it is your choice. A Full Balcony is another \$1000+ more again.

Airfares are not out yet, but we plan on flying Qatar Airlines as they fly direct from Adelaide, and into Prague and from Paris with only a single stop each way in Dohar of approximately 4 hours. We have also decided that we will maximise our travel investment, by adding additional stops in Prague (3 nights), Amsterdam (2 nights) and Paris (3 nights), with tours of these cities included.

## ADELAIDE OUTLAWS AMERICAN NIGHT JULY




Hi welcome to our club news and we trust everybody is enjoying their dancing.


