PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Presidents Report

Firstly, congratulations to Paddlesteamer Squares for celebrating their 17th Birthday during the past month. It is very pleasing to see our country clubs continuing to succeed. It was a lovely day to travel to beautiful Victor Harbor for an enjoyable afternoon of dancing. Great to see dancers getting behind the theme (70's) and dressing up and callers performing to 70's tunes.

It hardly seems like a year has gone by since I was elected President. Unfortunately, according to the constitution I am up for re-election this year, but rest assured I am standing again because there is still a lot of work to be done especially around publicity and marketing. Last month the Australian National Square Dance Society hosted a nationwide zoom meeting regarding a proposed nationwide plan to market and publicise Square Dancing. A subcommittee has been formed including me as a representative of SA. This committee also includes several people with marketing and media experience. So, look out for more information in coming months and please be prepared to happily participate in photo shoots or videos as we gather material that we hope will put square dancing on the map and encourage members of the public to participate in learners' classes.

I consider that we have achieved quite a lot in the past 12 month including:

- Re-establishing the calendar compilation process ensuring no clashes of events that could compromise attendance at important events such as club birthdays and society dances. This also maximises your opportunity to attend events. The new calendar is in the process of being released this month.
- The committee have redrafted and adopted a new yearly planner.
 This document helps the committee conduct business and plan events in a timely manner they can be publicised in the Round Up with plenty of notice.
- The early implementation of the added event each year. This was achieved in advance with the Roaring 20's dance held in august this year. This adds benefit to your membership by giving another

- opportunity for members to receive discounted admission and have fun with more dancing as well.
- We will also be implementing wherever possible alternating day/night events. We listened to your comments and understand that there are mixed preferences between day and night events. Having said that we were not able to achieve this for the Christmas dance 2025 & March Dance 2026 due to venue availability and the need balancing the need to alternate between events north and south of the city.

- Sunset Twirlers 30th.

We have seen clubs successfully commencing learner's classes this year including Adelaide Outlaws, Spin the Toppers & Sunset Twirlers. We have also had a new club commence in Whyalla called 'Steel City Squares' being run by Graham Burgan.

This is where our future lies in bringing new people into square dancing, especially with the Nationwide promotion and marketing plan about to be released. We are looking forward to increasing public awareness and increased numbers of learners joining our great activity.







THE NEW MAINSTREAM LIST

Back in March of this year, I wrote an article explaining the changes that, at that time, were to be voted on to modify both the Mainstream and Plus programs.

Well, fast forward to today and the new Mainstream (MS) list has been finalised and published. The vote was taken at the end of September this year and the changes were approved by a strong majority of 89% of the MS committee.



Just to context this, the committee was made up of some 200 Callerlab members from around the globe. Every Callerlab member had the opportunity to join.

What does this mean?

Well first and foremost, the official changeover will be 1st September 2026.

It is intended that we will continue to use our current MS & Plus programs up until Sept 1, 2026.

I have included the new MS list in this edition of Round-Up so you can see what changes have been made.

As important as what IS on the list is what is NOT on the list. I have included that to help gain a better understanding.

Those moves removed from the current MS program will go to the Plus program (post 1 Sept 2026.). The new Plus program is yet to be finalised.

I want to emphasise the point that this is all done to reduce the size of our entry level program to enable new learners to complete the (new) MS program quicker than they currently do. It also follows that there can be more learners class starts in a given period. Another outcome is that both MS and Plus programs will be approximately the same size.

Whilst some existing MS dancers may mourn the loss of some perceived more interesting calls, the onus is on callers now to make the new MS interesting and flowing with what we have on the new list.

What now?

Up to 1 Sept 2026, nothing on the dance floor should change. We continue to use our current MS and Plus programs.

After Sept 1 2026 - we dance to the new lists. This includes Conventions, festivals, Society dances and clubs.

Callers will need to be aware that teaching a MS class in the period leading up to Sept 1 2026 may mean teaching using the new MS list. There may be no need to teach moves that are not going to be used.

We may not agree with all the changes, but lets support the democratic process and embrace the changes. Please, if you have any questions, approach me or your caller.


